Learn System Operations, Distribution and Transmission Operations – Cleveland OH

NERC Certification at RC or TO level + PJM Transmission Operator Certification current or in 3 months

Education: AA degree in Engineering; BS EE preferred and/or 10-15 years' operating experience. Military Service preferred. Technically competent and proficient in all dimensions of system operations.

Must be able to work on a team for real time safe reliable operations. Act as chief point of contact with outside regulators from Reliability First, NERC or PJM and be able to discern what is being communicated, what pertains to the muni for immediate action and what should be targeted for action. Able to coordinate operations and compliance activities to assure effective real time training.

System Operator must be able effectively document events, trouble items and to communicate with other operators, distribution and engineering teams to prioritize work, to identify trouble issues for resolution. Must be able to coach, mentor and lead other operators, technically and to help them achieve and maintain competence, confidence and capabilities. Make recommendations for improving processes and systems as needed for safe reliable real time operations.

- ⊖ This is a working operator role able to grow to manage shift on his/her own and to coach and demonstrate proper work practices and procedures. Be capable and available to answer technical questions from Operations and Distribution personnel for resolution and/or prioritization.
- ⊖ This is the go to person in coordinating system needs with SCADA, distribution and engineering, leaders, management, interconnected company representatives and vendors.

Must learn/understand regulatory requirements to interface as a subject matter expert (SME) with Compliance Manager, City Leadership and outside regulators, RF, NERC, PJM periodically.

Project Management – must be able to develop and implement project plans as needed related to compliance, operations, engineering and system upgrades.

- ⊖ Provides or arranges provision of Training Plans and materials, schedules TO's work schedules to assure safe reliable 24-7 operations and compliance.
- ⊖ Capacity to effectively manage the Dispatch team during major system events, trouble events, and establish operating procedures, as needed, to provide on-going system operations excellence.

Must have the leadership, interpersonal and communications skills to work with existing processes, personnel and systems with a commitment to continuous improvement while balancing real time operation's needs, budgetary constraints and political realities. Capable, committed and competent.
